



Summer Camp Counsellor – Stratford-Perth

Counsellors will get to spend the summer developing their leadership skills while helping children understand the importance of humane education and interacting with our centre animals. The purpose of this job is to assist our Camp Director with maintaining a welcoming and controlled camp environment.

This position will work the following weeks, with three paid training days prior. Weekly commitment: 38 - 42 hours/week, approx. 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. You are required to be flexible with earlier or later start and finish times.

PRINCIPLE ACCOUNTABILITIES:

- Assist with morning set up and end of day cleaning
- Plan and execute games, crafts and activities
- Responsible for supervising camp group throughout the day
- Responsible for supervising the Education Room
- Reporting to Camp Director about health or behavioural problems with campers
- Responsible for assisting with maintaining a positive, energetic environment for all of the campers
- Take part in all games and activities, including setup/take down and leadership
- Help with general Education Room housekeeping throughout and at end of each camp day
- Ensure safety measures and SPHS policies are implemented at all times

POSITION REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be a student attending a secondary education in September
- Must have previous camp experience in a leadership role
- Must have a Police Information Check completed immediately after hire
- Must have up-to-date First Aid/CPR certification
- Must be able to follow direction
- Must possess an outgoing, positive attitude
- Must be comfortable interacting with children and ensuring they are all treated equally
- Must be comfortable supervising your camp group on your own
- Must be comfortable handling all types of animals
